June 5, 2007) - Technatomy Corporation announced today that it has completed a Standard Capability Maturity Model Integration (CMMI®) Appraisal Method for Process Improvement (SCAMPISM) evaluation of its Quality Management System. The SCAMPI appraisal provided benchmark quality ratings relative to the CMMI® for Development Version 1.2 model and included the integrated product and process development (IPPD) goals for team integration. The CMMI for Development model was developed by the Carnegie Mellon Software Engineering Institute (SEI) and is widely used throughout the world in a variety of industries for quality assurance. Technatomy's appraisal found the corporation has achieved a rating of Capability Level 3 for all Maturity Level 2 process areas of the model.

The appraisal was performed by a four member team led by Dr. Richard Bechtold, President of Abridge Technology, an SEI Authorized SCAMPI-A Lead Appraiser and was conducted during the period of May 29 through June 4 at Technatomy's Fairfax headquarters.
